### AUDIENCES:

*Academia*: publishing in discipline (capstone, thesis, dissertation, technical writing), research techniques (primary literature), presenting research, academic job preparation (future professors)

*General public*: presentation practice for general audiences, teaching (excluding children or graduate level)

*Savvy public*: teaching at the college level, presentation for informed audience, seminars, chalk-talks

*Funders*: writing grant proposals, communicating with funders and philanthropists

*Media*: writing and presenting for laypeople/broad audiences; interviewing; creating a hook

*Business/industry*: job preparation (creating CVs, practicing presentations, becoming a manager, human resources training), international work preparation (cross-cultural communication)

*Policy/law*: interpreting science for policy/law development

*Youth/children*: teaching pre-K and K-12, science education techniques
